DEPT. 12 SECTION 1 GRAIN AND SEED CROPS

A rosette will be awarded to "Best of Show."

1. No entry fee will be charged.
2. All farm products must be of the current year's growth, except Corn, Oats, and Buckwheat, which must be last year's crop.
3. All exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor.
4. Specimens must have size, color, uniformity, quality and condition.
5. Articles entered for single premium cannot compete for a display.
6. One entry per exhibitor per class.
7. The management reserves to the judges the right to disqualify inferior products.

Exhibitor Passes are issued for livestock exhibitors ONLY.

THE FAIR DOES NOT MAIL PREMIUM CHECKS.

Premium checks will be available **WHEN ANNOUNCED** on the last day of the Fair at the Fair office. **PLEASE WAIT UNTIL YOU HEAR THE ANNOUNCEMENT.** Premium checks will also be available on Sunday from 1 to 3 in the Arts/Crafts Building. If you cannot pick up your check, drop off a long (#10), self-addressed, stamped envelope (one per exhibitor) at the Fair office before or during Fair week.

Checks must be cashed by September 30 or they will become null and void. Checks will not be reissued.

Long hay only. (An exhibit shall consist of 1 sheaf or 1 bale section [flake] at least 8" thick, or an equivalent amount if cut from hay in the mow.)

1. **ALFALFA** or alfalfa grass mixed. Not over 50% of grasses.
2. **OTHER LEGUMES** or legume grass mixtures. Not over 50% grasses.
3. **GRASS**, Mixtures of timothy and/or other grasses and containing not more than 10% legumes.
4. **MIXED HAY**—any mixture not classified in the previous classes but which contains 50% or more singly or in combination of alfalfa, timothy, clover and grasses.
5. **SUMMER ANNUAL GRASSES**—Sudan grass, Sorghum-Sudan, hybrids, etc.
